

Commercial Lender Accreditation Program Checklist

(CUIC-DES-CL)

This 7-course program is accredited by Dalhousie University and was developed in conjunction with the Credit Union National Lenders Committee. The program design leads commercial lenders from foundational knowledge to more complex commercial credit situations. The course instructional formats vary and include: *CUIC*[®] courses and instructor-led courses.

The 3 credit union-specific *CUIC* courses are paper-based with the exception of Commercial Lending which is an online course. To receive credit for these courses, you must meet Dalhousie University's evaluation requirements (including passing a written exam).

On completion of this program, you will become an "Accredited Commercial Lender", an accreditation which is conferred jointly by CUIC Inc. and Dalhousie University.
